The 2023-2024 West Canada Valley Central School District budget totals \$21,212,431.00

The District

The West Canada Valley Central School located along the beautiful West Canada Creek is a 110 square mile District located in Herkimer County and is 10 miles from the village of Herkimer and 20 miles northeast of the city of Utica. Made up of the seven townships of Deerfield, Fairfield, Herkimer, Manheim, Newport, Norway and Schuyler, the District is primarily rural with two villages within its borders. The campus is made up of 88 acres including a full contingent of athletic fields and two school buildings which house a rigorous academic program. In addition, the District offers an extensive array of extracurricular opportunities including drama, music, interscholastic athletics, and many student-based clubs. With its dedicated faculty and staff, low student to teacher ratio, strong academic program, strong performing arts program and championship athletic teams, the District is proud of the West Canada Valley tradition.

The Position

The superintendency at the West Canada Valley Central School District presents unique, but rewarding challenges. Candidates must be prepared to offer leadership in a rural, small-school setting that takes great pride in the academic performance of its students.

As is typical in districts of this size, the Superintendent is called upon to manage the instructional program and to lead the finance and business management aspects of the district. There are tremendous opportunities for high quality interpersonal interactions with the members of the Board of Education, students, parents, faculty, and members of the community.

The Superintendent of West Canada Valley is assisted by a full-time business manager. All school buildings are located on one campus in Newport, NY. The activities of the adjoining high school and elementary school are conducted by building principals in those buildings.



Qualifications

The successful candidate will be an experienced educational leader who has served previously as a superintendent, central office administrator, or principal within a school district or BOCES. They must be able to demonstrate:

- A genuine commitment to the education of children and a strong educational background.
- The ability to direct and plan within a multifaceted educational delivery system that speaks to the needs of the school district.
- The ability to be practical and creative in fiscal matters and to design long and short-term financial strategies to make effective use of all resources.
- The ability to manage, develop, devise, and implement effective personnel policies, especially as they impact hiring, staff evaluations, professional growth and the well being of the supervisory district.
- The ability to be an effective communicator through both written and spoken language.
- The ability to be an active listener, to articulate the goals of the organization and to develop new goals as needed.
- The skills to interact with the West Canada Valley Board of Education, presenting the Board with timely and appropriate information.
- The ability to execute viable plans for improving student achievement.

In addition, the successful candidate will:

- Possess NYS School District Administrator or School District Leader certification.
- Must be able to attend to the position's responsibilities, often beyond the typical work day.
